The ARS60 is a portable, wireless stereo speaker featuring a portable design and compact footprint

Users can stream music wirelessly from any cell phone, tablet, computer, lanton or mp3 player supporting Bluetooth

The ARS60 outputs 16 watts RMS audio power, with two speakers on the front and a high efficiency bass reflex system situated at the back of the unit.

The integrated rechargeable battery ensures 3 to 4 hours of non-stop, maximum-volume music, and up to 10 hours of moderately played melodies.

The ARS60 comes with a 3.5 mm stereo jack cable for devices that do not support Bluetooth A2DP.


