Make sure the following items came in this package.

- · ARS60 wireless speaker
- · AC charging adapter
- 3.5mm audio cable
- Speaker carrying pouch

Step 2: Charge the speaker

Before you start using the ARS60 wireless speaker, you need to charge its built-in battery.





Plug one end of the included AC adapter into the DC jack on the back of the speaker. Plug the other end of the charging cable into a wall outlet or surge protector.



The charging indicator on the back of the speaker turns red while charging. It turns green when the speaker is fully charged.

IMPORTANT: To get the most from your ARS60 speaker, make sure you charge its battery completely before its first use.

Step 3: Turn on



Press and hold the \bigcirc button on the top of the ARS60 until you hear a beep.



If this is the first time you're turning the speaker on:

The ARS60 goes directly to pairing mode—the **M** button blinks red until the speaker is paired with a device.

If you've turned the speaker on before: The **III** button flashes red three times (the ARS60 is trying to connect with the last Bluetooth device).

Bluetooth Wireless Connection Tips

- · Make sure the Bluetooth capability of your device is turned on.
- The ARS60 Bluetooth wireless connection works up to a range of roughly 33 feet (10
 meters). This range may vary, however, based on other factors, such as room layout,
 wall material, obstacles, your device's Bluetooth performance, etc. If you're having
 problems connecting to the ARS60, move closer to it.
- · Make sure your device supports audio transfer A2DP.
- If your device asks you for a password to connect to the ARS60, use "0000".

Step 4: Pair and connect



Enable Bluetooth on your device (smartphone, MP3 player, etc.).



If this is the first time you're turning the speaker on: The 🔰 button should still be blinking red. You're ready to pair and connect.

If it isn't blinking red: Press and hold the **III** button on the top of the ARS60 until the speaker beeps twice. The **III** button blinks red, signalling that the speaker is in pairing mode again.



Choose "AR ARS60" on your device.

IMPORTANT: The process of enabling Bluetooth and connecting varies from device to device. See your device's owners manual for more information and specific instructions.



The **MI** button stops blinking red and the speaker emits an audible signal when you're connected. Your device is connected and ready to use with the speaker.

IMPORTANT: If a previously paired device is in range while you're trying to pair a new device, turn off Bluetooth on the previously paired device while you're pairing with the new one.

Step 5: Play music



Set your device's volume for music to 50%.


Note: This is to make sure the sound from the speaker isn't too loud when you start streaming.



Start playing music or other audio on your device. Within seconds, the speaker starts streaming the audio wirelessly via Bluetooth.

To adjust the volume of your audio: Use the Volume controls on the speaker or on your device. When the speaker reaches its maximum or minimum volume, it beeps. To increase or decrease volume further, adjust volume on your device.

Using the Auxiliary Audio In



Use the 3.5mm audio cable included with the speaker to connect the audio output from your device to the audio input on the ARS60 back panel.


If you're streaming audio via Bluetooth to the speaker, you'll need to pause it or turn off Bluetooth on your device to hear audio from the speaker's 3.5mm audio input.
