

Congratulations on purchasing your new RCA Player.

Please read these instructions for quick tips on using the player.

Getting started

- 1. Connect the player to your PC as shown.
- Player 2. The RCA easyRip™ Media Software installer is stored in the player, go to MyComputer in the Start menu, find and open the drive letter associated with the player (i.e. LYRA) and then double-click the **rcaeasyrip setup** file to launch the installer. The player charges automatically every time you connect it to
- vour computer.
- It should be **charged for at least 3 hours** before using for the ^{computer} first time.
- 3. Transfer audio files to your player using either of the two methods below:
- a) RCA easyRip: Helps to rip CD's, create playlists, load content and manage your library with an intuitive and modular design. Click the easyRip icon () on your PC desktop to launch the software.
- For details in using RCA easyRip, click the **Help** icon () on the module dock.
- * RCA easyRip is currently not compatible with DRM files and Audiobooks.



Your RCA Player is also compatible with most PC music management softwares.



4. Disconnect the player from your PC by clicking the **Safely Remove Hardware** icon (👺) in the system tray (located in the lower right corner of your screen) and selecting the player from the list of devices, then unplug the player from the PC.

Step 1: Click Start.

Step 2: Click My Computer (XP users) / Click Computer (Vista and 7 users).

Step 3: Find and open the drive letter associated with the player (i.e. LYRA) and then open User Manuals folder.



General controls




Turn the player on/off	Slide ტ / ato the right
Go to the Home menu (to access Music, Audiobooks, Voice Memo, Favorites and Settings)	Press and hold Ć

	:
Play an audio file	Press »I or III
Pause playback	Press III at the playback (Now playing) screen, press again to resume
Show the Option menu	Press 🗏
Adjust the volume	Press + or – at the playback (Now playing) screen
Skip to the next file (or section of audiobooks*)	Press »I
Skip to the previous file (or section of audiobooks*)	Press ^{I≪} within the first 4 seconds of the current audio file
Reverse or fast forward an audio file	Press and hold ≪ or ≫ during playback
Lock the keys	Slide \mathfrak{G}/\mathbb{A} to the left. To unlock, slide \mathfrak{G}/\mathbb{A} to the middle position.
Delete files from the player	Refer to page 17-22 of the user manual
Reset the player	Press the RESET button on the back of the player with a non-metal pointed object (e.g. toothpick).
