Please read these instructions for quick tips on using the Player.

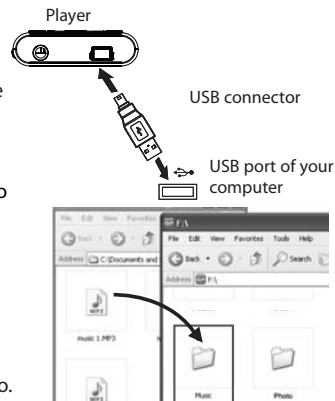
A comprehensive User Manual in your selected language (English, Spanish, or French) will be copied to your PC as part of the software installation. You can find the User Manual PDF file on your desktop. The User Manual PDF file can also be found in the Player memory under the User Manuals folder.

## Getting Started

1. Connect your Player to your computer. The Player charges automatically every time you connect it to your computer. The Player should be **charged for at least 3 hours** before using for the first time.
2. Transfer audio/video/photo files to your Player by dragging and dropping files using Windows Explorer. Drag-and-drop audio/photo files to the **Internal Storage** folder (Windows Vista™, Windows® 7) or the **Music** or **Photo** folder (Windows® XP) of the Player.
- The Player is also compatible with most PC music management software.

**Tips:** Drag and drop text files into the Text folder.


3. Disconnect the Player from the computer and enjoy media on the go.

4. Video files must be converted by RCA AMV Converter for playback on your Player. To install RCA AMV Converter, go to **My Computer** (XP users) /Go to **Computer** (Vista and 7 users) in the Start menu, find and open the drive letter associated with the Player (i.e. RCA MP3) and then double-click the **RCA\_AMVConverter\_setup.exe** file to launch the installer.

For detailed explanation on using RCA AMV Converter, click the Help module  on the Module Dock.

### IMPORTANT:

- Before transferring files to the Player, make sure the Player is unlocked by sliding the Lock Slider towards the un-lock icon (🔓) (Towards the headphone jack). Otherwise, the Player is write-protected and file transfer is not allowed.
- Video and photo files must be transferred to their respective folders on the Player to ensure proper detection and playback.

Step 2: Click **My Computer** (XP users) / Click **Computer** (Vista and 7 users).

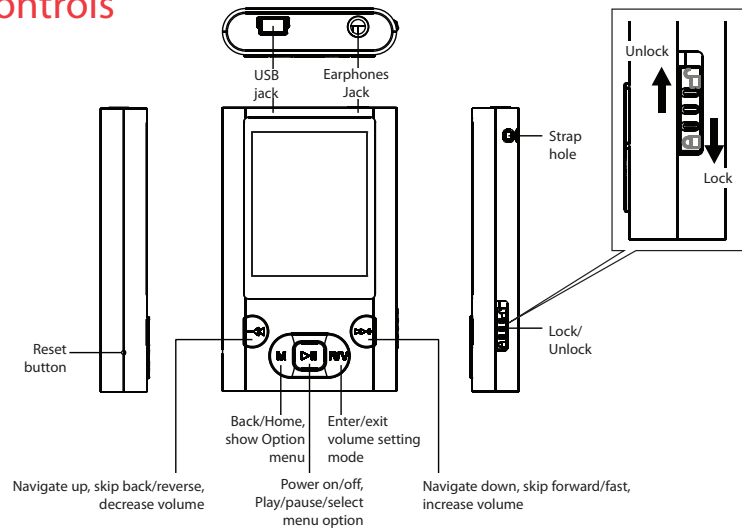
Step 3: Find and open the drive letter associated with the Player (i.e. RCA MP3) and then open User Manuals folder.

## General controls



Turn the Player on/off	Press and hold <b>II</b> .
Lock/Unlock the Player	To lock, slide the Lock Slider towards the Lock icon (🔒) (Away from the headphone jack). To unlock, slide the Lock Slider towards the un-lock icon (🔓) (Towards the headphone jack).
Go to the Home menu (to access Music, Video, Voice Rec, Voice Playback, Picture, Text Reader, Browser and Settings)	Press and hold <b>M</b> to return to the menu.

Access Music, Video, Voice Rec, Voice Playback, Picture, Text Reader, Browser and Settings functions	In Home menu, press - <b>◀/▶</b> + to navigate to the desired function and press <b>II</b> to enter.
Navigate to an audio/video/photo file	In the Home menu, press - <b>◀/▶</b> + to navigate to Browser. Press <b>II</b> to enter Browser mode. Press - <b>◀/▶</b> + to highlight a folder or a file and press <b>II</b> to enter selected folder or start playback of selected file.
Play an audio/video/photo file	Press <b>II</b> .
Pause playback	Press <b>II</b> , press again to resume.
Show the Option menu	Press <b>M</b> while at the playback screen.
Adjust the volume	Press <b>R/V</b> to enter volume setting mode. Then press - <b>◀/▶</b> + to adjust the volume.
Skip to the next file	Press <b>▶ +</b> .
Skip to the previous file	Press - <b>◀</b> .
Reverse or fast forward an audio file	Press and hold - <b>◀/▶</b> + during playback.
Reset the Player (if it is not responding)	Press the <b>RESET</b> button on the left side of the Player with a non-metal pointed object (e.g. toothpick).
