- To install the batteries:

  1. Remove battery compartment door (located at the bottom of the device) by applying thumb pressure to the tab on battery door and then lift the door out and off the cabinet.
- 2. Insert 2 AA batteries (not included) to the battery compartment.
- Replace the compartment door.

### Power failure indicator

If you have not installed 2 AA batteries (not included) in the product, or the batteries run out while power is interrupted, all the settings (clock and alarm) will be lost. After AC power is restored, the digital display will flash to indicate that power was interrupted and you should readjust the time and alarm settings.

Note: It is recommended to replace the batteries at least once per year even if no power failures have occurred.
