In some cases it's more affordable to add the SM-TP-71P to your vehicle than it is to replace a single OEM tire sensor" Cooper concluded.

The kit includes all necessary installation hardware and both <u>Black</u> & <u>Silver</u> sensor covers so that you can match the look of your rim.
